

# KPRL 2006 Quarter Midget Rules

The intent is to create and maintain a safe and healthy sport for families to enjoy together. Providing an environment in which our younger generation can acquire greater skills in mechanical devices, coordination, alertness and sportsmanship.

## Driver Requirements

1. Age 6yrs. to 16yrs old
2. Current KPRL Minor Release form on file with club officer

## Personal Safety

1. Helmets: Must be at least DOT approved in good condition; Snell M2000 rating is recommended and maybe required in the future.
2. Race Wear: Leather jackets, Cordura or Fire/Flame retardant material is recommended but all must have full length sleeves that zip or fasten up to the neckline, also full length pant that go to the ankles
3. **Face Shield or Goggles must be worn.** Tear-offs optional
4. Leather or Fire/flame retardant gloves must be worn.
5. Shoes must completely cover feet
6. **SFI approved neck braces are required**

## Vehicle Safety

1. Minimum of SFI approved 4 pt harness - 5 pt recommended
2. All bumpers and nerf bars are to be intact and properly installed
3. Fuel tanks shall have shut off valve that is accessible through bodywork
4. Throttle controls should work freely without binding or sticking and have minimum of two return springs.
5. Brakes must be functional on at least 1 axle.
6. Arm restraints are **required**
7. Debris Screen is recommended for Dirt Tracks

## Classes

1. Honda 120: Any Quarter Midget of America (QMA) approved 1/4 Midget chassis with GX120 Honda Engine
2. Honda 160: Same as above with GX160 Honda engine.  
**Note:** This class will be run and scored with Honda 120 until at least 2 qualifying cars are entered in either 120 or 160 class.

## Point Scoring 2006 Pavement Series

1. Heat Races: 1<sup>st</sup> 3 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> 2pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> 1pt.
2. Final Races: 1<sup>st</sup> 9pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> 7pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> 5pts, 4<sup>th</sup> 3pts, 5<sup>th</sup> 2pts, 6<sup>th</sup> 1pts.
3. Points accumulate to Season Championship
4. Trophy Dash counts as Heat race for points.
5. **Northstar Speedway races--- Lowest race date scores will be dropped from season point's total. (this will allow for 1 missed race)**

# KPRL 2006 Quarter Midget Rules

## Start / Restarts

1. All Starts are inverted; **fastest car from last heat will start in back.**
2. **Restarts (after first lap completed) will be single file in order based on last completed lap. The car(s) that is found to have caused restart will be started last on restart**
3. When Timing equipment is not available Drivers will draw for first Heat starting position.

## Driver/Handler Conduct

1. Handler will be present and available during all races.
2. Handler is responsible for the conduct of driver at all times on and off the track.
3. There will be no intentional contact allowed.
  - A. First violation will be a verbal warning.
  - B. Second violation will cause loss of position and points for heat/race.
  - C. Third violation driver/handler will be disqualified from event.
  - D. Further violation at following events may cause suspension of racing privileges for time period to be determined by KPRL Circle Track Directors.
4. Good Sportsmanship is mandatory at all times from both the Driver and Handler.

## Entry Fee's

1. Kenai Peninsula Racing Lions current members \$5.00 per event day (pit pass not included)
2. **Non- KPRL members \$25.00 (pit pass not included) non-member will not be scored for season points total. Non- KPRL members may, after the 5<sup>th</sup> non-member entry, apply for membership using funds (less trophy fee) from 5 entries's to pay the KPRL first time membership fee of \$100.00 All previous 2006 race points will then be applied to season totals.**
3. **The base entry fee's (\$5.00) will go to season trophy fund. Any balances to KPRL Circle Track Div.**

## Temporary Tracks

1. All Handlers and Drivers will help with track setup and tear down.
2. **Entry fee's** will be based on facility and setup costs divided by #entries.
3. Supplementary rules may apply and will be distributed to entrants' prior to start of event.
